
Operating exclusively in "b2b" market, all the <u>electrical motors</u> (asynchronous single-phase, three-phase, brake-motors and permanent magnet motors, with or without drive on board) supplied by Lafert are strictly designed, developed and manufactured according to the customized technical specifications of its own Customers so <u>exclusively produced to be embedded on specific industrial machines</u>, equipments and tools (manufactured by the purchasers themselves or their customers) for what they have been designed; for this reason they are not separable from the expected destination for the right functionality, nor can be used for other / different applications (industrial or not).

With the impossibility to widely grant the right disposal of the motors at the end of their lifetime, against some end-users of the industrial applications for which the motors have been originally manufactured, Lafert S.p.A. had also decided to:

- a) Register the Company Lafert S.p.A. to the authorized body **APIRAEE** (Via Pianezza n. 123, I-10151, Torino, Italy, <u>info@apiraee.it</u>, <u>www.apiraee.it</u>, +39.011.4513192) to regulate all collecting and disposal practices of the <u>standard asynchronous single-phase electrical motors</u> supplied to our <u>domestic resellers/distributors</u> as "*general purpose spare parts*", because potentially they would be used in other applications rather than the original designed ones, and consequently self-disposed by third parties as "WEEE".
- b) Register the Company Lafert S.p.A. into the National Register of EEE manufacturers, www.registroaee.it, to assure the annual declaration of the above motors' quantities supplied on the market as <u>Category 4.12</u> "*Big monitoring and control tools"*, as per IT Law D.Lgs. n. 49/2014 and n. 118/2020:
